The Union County Fiscal Court met in regular session with the Honorable Jody Jenkins presiding. Magistrates present were Day, Floyd, Voss, Wells, and Clements.

The meeting opened at 5:30p.m. with a prayer by magistrate Joe Wells and the pledge to the American Flag.

The Minutes of the previous meetings were approved by Magistrate Day, seconded by Magistrate Wells, motion carried.

Judge Jenkins presented a MOA between the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Kentucky Infrastructure Authority and the Union County Fiscal Court for the release of funds for the Waverly Sanitary Sewer Rehab Project and giving him the authority to sign all necessary documents. A motion to adopt this Resolution was made by Magistrate Clements, seconded by Magistrate Floyd, motion carried.

Magistrate Voss made a motion to allow the claims against the General, Road, LGEA and Jail funds, seconded by Clements, motion carried.

Magistrate Clements made a motion to allow the transfers, seconded by Magistrate Floyd, motion carried.

Bradley Vowels, Vista/Ameri-Corp volunteer for Union County presented the Court with a park/recreation project. Union County is eligible for a 50/50 match grant through GRADD to improve a park/recreation area. Bradley recommended Moffit Lake, Caseyville Riverfront, and The City of Sturgis Walking trail connecting with walking trail at the Sturgis Airport. The Court agreed to use the grant on Caseyville riverfront. Judge Jenkins asked Bradley Vowels to come up with some estimates on how much this will cost and then they would move forward with the project.

There being no further business to come before the court, a motion to adjourn was made by Magistrate Floyd, seconded by Magistrate Clements, motion carried.
