The Union County Fiscal Court met in regular session with Magistrate Joe Clements presiding due to Judge Jenkins being out of town. Magistrates present were Day, Floyd, Voss, Wells, and Clements.

The meeting opened at 9:00 a.m. at the Union County Library with a prayer by Bro. Jerry Manning and the pledge to the American Flag.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were approved with a motion made by Magistrate Wells, seconded by Magistrate Floyd, motion carried.

Beth Thomas, Jennifer Pinkston, and Jerry Baird with KY ASAP updated the Court on a \$20,000.00 grant that they received to bring awareness to our Community on opiate and heroin use. The \$20,000 will be spent on supplies, guest speakers for forums, a billboard on Hwy. 60, and resources for first responders.

Ken Ford with River View Coal presented their property tax check in the amount of \$1,696,591.08.

Garrick Thompson, Community Development Director presented to the Court that on October 13, 2015 it was suggested that our community become a Work Ready Community. Mr. Thompson said that the actual vote to see if Union County will become Work Ready will take place on November 19, 2015.

Kathy Baird with the Union County Dog Pound presented the Court with an update. Mrs. Baird reported that numbers have increased from 2014, with a total of 377 dogs having gone through the dog pound since January, 2015. Mrs. Baird also reported that so far in the month of October 36 dogs have gone to rescue, and the pony has been released to rescue.

County Clerk, Trey Peak proposed an increase in the precinct workers pay with school pay rising from \$15.00 to \$30.00, and Election Day pay rising from \$105.00 to \$125.00. Magistrate Day made a motion to table this subject until our next Court date on November 10, 2015 at 9:00 a.m.

Magistrate Day made a motion to acknowledge receipt of the September Treasurer Report, seconded by Magistrate Voss, motion carried.

Magistrate Floyd made a motion to acknowledge receipt of the Treasurer Quarterly Report, seconded by Magistrate Clements, motion carried.
