The Union County Fiscal Court met in regular session with Magistrate Joe Clements presiding due to Judge Jenkins being out of town. Magistrates present were Day, Floyd, Voss, Wells, and Clements.

The meeting opened at 5:30 p.m. with a prayer by Magistrate Wells and the pledge to the American Flag.

Magistrate Clements made a motion to make two corrections to the September 22, 2015 minutes with the first corrections changing Williamson to Williams and the second correction changing Culver Ln. to Coburn Ln. Magistrate Floyd made a motion to approve the minutes with the above stated corrections, seconded by Magistrate Day, motion carried.

The Leadership class lead by Garrick Thompson presented their recycle project to the Court and asked the Court for financial support. Lissa Gibson, County Treasurer verified that the County does in fact have the funds available for financial support from the Litter Abatement Grant. Magistrate Wells made a motion to financially support the project, seconded by Magistrate Floyd, motion carried.

Magistrates acknowledged receipt of claims and transfers with no changes.

Magistrate Wells informed the Court that the Sturgis Senior Center received a great monitoring review.

Gus Kanipe approached the Court asking if the Court would make a site determination for a transfer station before he spends money on the many fees that have to be paid to get the transfer station built. The Court informed Mr. Kanipe that a decision could not be made on his request at this time.

There being no further business to come before the Court, a motion to adjourn was made by Magistrate Floyd, seconded by Magistrate Day, motion carried.
