The meeting opened at 9:00 a.m. with a prayer by Bother Jerry Manning and the pledge to the American Flag.

The Union County Fiscal Court met in a regular meeting with Judge O’Nan presiding. Magistrates present were Wyatt, Floyd, Ricketts, and Clements. Magistrate Byrnes was not in attendance.

The minutes from the September 24, 2019 Fiscal Court meeting were accepted as read.

Judge O’Nan opened the one bid from M. Bowling, Inc. for the Uniontown Dredging Project. The bid was for 1,300 c.y. @ 21.00 per c.y. for a total of \$27,300.00. Sean Sheffer reviewed the bid, and advised the Court that everything looked good on the bid. Magistrate Floyd made a motion to accept the bid from M. Bowling, Inc. in the amount of \$27,300.00, seconded by Magistrate Clements, motion carried.

Jeff Canter with PFGW Architects advised the Court that the construction drawing for the Courthouse elevator is done, but still needs to be submitted to the State. Mr. Canter feels we are ready to bid the project out. Magistrate Floyd made a motion to advertise for bids on October 16, 2019 and October 23, 2019, have a pre-bid meeting on November 6, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. and open bids at a regular scheduled fiscal Court meeting on November 26, 2019 at 9:00 a.m., seconded by Magistrate Ricketts, motion carried.

Sheriff Arnold presented the 2018 unmined coal tax, with a collection of 91.11%. 100 of the bills were delinquent with 32 of those 100 being unknown. Magistrate Floyd made a motion to approve the 2018 unmined coal tax report, seconded by Magistrate Clements, motion carried.

Magistrate Floyd made a motion to set advertisement dates for October 16, 2019 and October 23, 2019 for RFP’s for engineering services, and to open bids on October 29, 2019 at 5:30 p.m., seconded by Magistrate Wyatt, motion carried.

Magistrate Wyatt made a motion to set advertisement date for October 16, 2019 and October 23, 2019 for the replacement bridge on Bunger Rd. and to open bids on October 29, 2019 at 5:30 p.m., seconded by Magistrate Ricketts, motion carried.

Magistrate Floyd made a motion to set advertisement dates for October 9, 2019 and October 16, 2019 for two new boilers located at the Courthouse, and to open bids on October 22, 2019 at 9:00 a.m., seconded by Magistrate Ricketts, motion carried.

Magistrate Clements made a motion to set advertisement dates for October 16, 2019 and October 23, 2019 for a limb attachment for the excavator and to open bids October 29, 2019 at 5:30 p.m., seconded by Magistrate Ricketts, motion carried.

Magistrate Wyatt made a motion to approve transfers, seconded by Magistrate Floyd, motion carried.

All claims are to be paid.

Magistrate Wyatt excused himself before Russell Wyatt with Morganfield Rescue Squad advised the Court that Morganfield Rescue Squad has found a building they would like to house the Morganfield Rescue Squad. The building they are looking at is the Andy Downs building. The building will cost \$65,000.00, but it will need plumbing put in, heat and air, and office space added. The Court advised Russell to get quotes for the work that needs to be done after the purchase of the building, and we will discuss this again at the next court meeting.

Melissa Coker, Director of Union County First gave an update on Health First that is moving to the old KU building. Melissa advised that Health First will treat patients no matter their insurance status, they will offer a prescription medicine program for those who qualify. Health First is looking for employees to fill the new office in Morganfield.

There being no further business to come before the Court, a motion to adjourn was made by Magistrate Floyd, seconded by Magistrate Ricketts, motion carried.
