The Union County Fiscal Court met in regular session with the Honorable Jody Jenkins presiding. Magistrates present were Day, Floyd, Voss, Wells and Clements.

The meeting opened at 9:00 a.m. with a prayer by Bro. Jerry Manning and the pledge to the American Flag.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were approved with a motion made by Magistrate Day, seconded by Magistrate Wells, motion carried.

Shirley Mercer, Asst. Director of the Union Count Library presented to the Court that the Union County Public Library set their 2015 tax rate at 7.7 cents per \$100 assessed valuation of Real Property and 9.10 cents per \$100 assessed valuation of Personal Property. Mrs. Mercer also informed the Court that the 2015 summer read and feed program was a success and that attendance was up a little from previous years.

Judge Jenkins recommended that the County keep 2015 tax rate at 9.1 cents per \$100. Magistrate Clements made a motion to keep the tax rate at 9.1 cents per \$100, seconded by Magistrate Day, motion carried.

Judge Jenkins presented the Resolution of the Union County Board of Health Establishing Public Health Tax Rate for the year 2015, with the tax rate being set at 2.5 cent assessed valuation of all personal property, and at the rate of 2.5 cents per \$100 of the assessed valuation of all motor vehicles in Union County.

Judge Jenkins presented a resolution for the Union County Fiscal Court Grievance Procedure for Comments Received regarding CDBG Projects. Magistrate Voss Made a motion to approve said Resolution, seconded by Magistrate Wells, motion carried.

Judge Jenkins presented a Resolution for the Grievance Procedure for Complaints Relating to Suspected Allegations of Discrimination on the Basis of Handicapped Status in Union County, KY. Magistrate Clements made a motion to approve said resolution, seconded by Magistrate Floyd, motion carried.

Magistrate Voss made a motion to acknowledge receipt of Claims and Transfers, seconded by Magistrate Day, motion carried.

Magistrate Voss made a motion to approve the July Treasurer's Report, seconded by magistrate Floyd, motion carried.

Judge Jenkins made a recommendation to extend the dog pound's part-time employee, Amanda Johns through December 31, 2015 making minimum wage, seconded by Magistrate Day, motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Court, a motion to adjourn was made by Magistrate Day, seconded by Magistrate Voss, motion carried.
