UNION COUNTY FISCAL March 22, 2016

The Union County Fiscal Court met in regular session with the Honorable Jody Jenkins presiding. Magistrates present were Day, Floyd, Voss, Wells and Clements.

The meeting opened at 9:00 a.m. with a prayer by Bro. Jerry Manning, and the pledge to the American Flag.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were approved with a motion made by Magistrate Day, seconded by Magistrate Wells, motion carried.

Judge Jenkins presented an MOA Amendment to Union County Fiscal Court – County Projects (HB 235) to add \$374,811.00 for a total of \$1,446,305.00 and to extend the project to June 30, 2018. Magistrate Wells mad a motion to approve said amendment, seconded by Magistrate Floyd, motion carried.

Judge Jenkins presented an MOA Amendment to Union County Fiscal Court – Braves to College (HB 235) to add \$100,000.00 for a total of \$200,000.00 and extend the project to June 30, 2018. Magistrate Wells made a motion to approve said amendment, seconded by Magistrate Floyd, motion carried.

Magistrate Clements made a motion to approve claims, except for the claim to Brown Supply in the amount of \$72.56, seconded by Magistrate Floyd, motion carried.

Magistrate Wells informed the Court that Wynnaddition subdivision is still having some standing water in an ally and asked the court if they would be ok with the road department running a hard line from a pump to the nearest ditch to help with the water standing in the ally. The Court asked Magistrate Wells to get some pricing and bring it back to another Court meeting.

Judge Jenkins brought to the Court's attention that Chapman Rd. bridge a bridge that the Court bid out in 2013 is sitting in E & H's yard and has been paid for, but the installer never showed up to install the bridge. The Court agreed to revisit this issue on March 29, 2016.

James Cooper, Union County Road Department Foreman informed the Court that they still have a road grater down, and a truck down. Judge Jenkins asked the Court if they would be interested in a leasing program to lease a truck for the road department. Magistrate Voss made a motion to give Judge Jenkins permission to lease a tandem truck for the road department, seconded by Magistrate Clements, motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Court, a motion to adjourn was made by Magistrate Floyd, seconded by Magistrate Day, motion carried.
